### SARS-CoV-2 INFORMATION / PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF EUROPEAN REGULATION 2016/679

In compliance with current legislation on the processing of personal data, as defined by the provisions contained in Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR"), as well as by virtue of the General Protocol for combating and containing the spread of the Covid-19 virus in Motorsport issued by the ACI Sport Federation ("ACI Sport Protocol"), this information sheet describes the processing activities of your personal data carried out by Mugello Circuit S.p.A. ("Data Controller" or "Mugello").

#### 1. DATA CONTROLLER AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

The Data Controller is Mugello Circuit S.p.A., headquartered at Via Senni 15, 50038 Scarperia e San Piero (FI), Italy. You can contact the Data Protection Officer at the following email address privacy@ferrari.com.

### 2. TYPES OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

Personal data ("Data") processed by Mugello concerning the COVID-19 emergency are collected directly from the Data Subject through the self-certification referred to in the preceding pages.

The types of Data that Mugello collects and/or receives only for the purposes detailed below are:

- personal identification data;
  - special categories of personal data, meaning those relating to the state of health of the Data Subject which Mugello may process in the context of an emergency;
- data concerning relations with the so-called close contacts where necessary to cooperate with the Health Authority or if communicated to Mugello by the Data Subject.

#### 3. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING

The personal data provided by you are processed by the Data Controller exclusively to reduce the risk and prevent infection with SARS-CoV-2 (Covid-19) and to allow you to access the racetrack and participate in the sporting competition.

The legal basis of the data processing is the need to comply with legal obligations to which the Data Controller is subject, as provided for under Article 6, letter c) of the GDPR, in relation to the implementation of anti-infection safety protocols as well as the ACI Sport Protocol. Considering that, on the basis of the indications contained in the ACI Sport Protocol, a declaration is required that you are not subject to quarantine, that you do not have Covid-19 (coronavirus disease), that you do not have or have not had in the last 5 days a body temperature higher than 37.5°, or that you do not have or have not had in the last 5 days any of the other symptoms, namely: (i) severe reduction in the sense of taste (flavours), (ii) severe reduction in the sense of smell (odours), (iii) dry cough, (iv) difficulty breathing, (v) severe fatigue, (vi) nasal congestion, (vii) headache, (viii) diarrhoea, or not having been in contact with who have tested positive for coronavirus in the previous 14 days, or with their family members, even if asymptomatic, any refusal by the Data Subject to issue the above statement will make it impossible for the Data Controller to comply with legal obligations and, consequently, your inability to enter the competition area.

#### 4. METHOD OF PROCESSING

We would like to inform you that the processing of your data is carried out in compliance with the GDPR and the current regulations on the processing of personal data. We inform you that the processing in question is based on the principles laid down in accordance with Article 5 of the GDPR, in particular the principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of confidentiality and rights of the person whose data are being processed. The processing of your personal data will be carried out using paper, computerised and telematic means, with suitable methods to ensure their security and confidentiality in accordance with the provisions of Article 32 of the GDPR.

### 5. COMMUNICATION OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data collected by the Data Controller shall not be communicated or disseminated to third parties, except in the event that the Data Controller is required to do so by specific regulatory provisions (e.g. Public and Health Authorities).

#### 6. **RELOCATION TO THIRD COUNTRIES**

Your personal data will neither be transferred to nor stored in Third Countries.

### DATA RETENTION

Mugello does not store or record temperature measurement data regardless of whether or not the measurement indicates that the threshold of 37.5° has been exceeded. Mugello reserves the right to identify the Data Subject and record the exceeding of the temperature threshold only if it is necessary to document the reasons for preventing access to the premises. The other personal data are retained by the Data Controller for the time necessary to achieve the above purposes, to comply with the provisions of the law and the indications of the ACI Sport Protocol as well as to satisfy any specific requests by the Public Authorities. The personal data, including personal particulars, are subject to retention for a longer period, within the limits of the statute of limitations of rights, in relation to requirements related to the exercise of the right of defence in case of disputes.

#### 7. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

The Data Subject, with reference to the data concerning them, may exercise the following rights:

- the right of access, in other words, the right to obtain from Mugello, confirmation of whether the Data are being processed and if they are, to access them;
- the right of rectification and erasure, the right to obtain rectification of inaccurate data concerning them and/or the integration of incomplete Data or the erasure of data for legitimate reasons;
- the right to limit the data processing, in other words the right to request suspension of processing if there are legitimate reasons;
- the right to data portability, in other words the right to receive the Data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and send it to
  another data controller;
- the right of objection, the right to object to the processing of Data if there are legitimate reasons;
- the right to contact the data protection authority if the Data are used unlawfully.
- To exercise the rights referred to above, the Data Subject may contact the Data Controller by writing to:

The deadline for replying to the Data Subject is thirty days, which can be extended up to two months in particularly complex cases. In such cases, the Data Controller shall provide at least one interim communication to the Data Subject by the thirty-day deadline referred to in Article 12 of the GDPR. The exercise of rights is, in principle, free of charge; the Data Controller reserves the right to ask for a contribution in the event of any manifestly unfounded or excessive (including repetitive) requests, also in light of the indications that may be provided by the Privacy Guarantor. The Data Subject has, pursuant to Article 13.2, letter g), GDPR, the possibility of lodging a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority, which can be contacted at the website https://www.garanteprivacy.it/
